POWER AMPLIFIER FOR GSM CLASS 4 HANDSETS**

**DESCRIPTION**

The NE5500434 is an N-channel silicon power MOS FET specially designed as the transmission power amplifier for GSM class 4 handsets. Dies are manufactured using our NEWMOS technology (our 0.6  $\mu$ m WSi gate lateral MOS FET), housed in a surface mount 3-pin power minimold (34 PKG) (SOT-89 type) package. The device can deliver 35 dBm output power with 63% power added efficiency at 900 MHz under the 4.8 V supply voltage.

The NE5500434 also can deliver 31.5 dBm output power with 60% power added efficiency at 3.6 V.






DRAIN CURRENT vs. DRAIN TO SOURCE VOLTAGE




SET DRAIN CURRENT vs. GATE TO SOURCE VOLTAGE





OUTPUT POWER, EFFICIENCY vs. INPUT POWER




DRAIN CURRENT vs. INPUT POWER

POWER ADDED EFFICIENCY vs. INPUT POWER


