Redefinition of TEST_SPARE[2] pin

The TEST_SPARE[2] pin has been redefined to provide users with additional flexibility for parking the PCI bus when it is idle. When TEST_SPARE[2] is tied low, the PCI bus arbiter will park the bus on the last master. When TEST_SPARE[2] is tied high or is left as a no connect, the PCI bus arbiter will park the bus on the Tsi381.



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
