Chapter 2. Operating Environment

2.1 Hardware environment

- System: 1.8 GHz or faster 64-bit processor. Dual-core or better recommended. Apple Silicon (arm64) processors are only supported.
- Memory capacity: 4GB of RAM; 8GB of RAM recommended
- Capacity of hard disk: At least 2 GB of free space.

- macOS 15 Sequoia

Software for Floating License Management

- Software for Floating License Management V2.08.00 or later
- Software for Floating License Management V2.08.00 (for Linux) or later

Chapter 3. Functions

3.1 General

The license manager provides facilities for managing licenses which are required to use tools related to the integrated development environments for microcontrollers from Renesas.

3.3 Glossary

Term	Description
Node-Locked License	<p>A license to be assigned to a particular PC.</p> <p>This license is managed by the license manager on the same PC on which tools related to the integrated development environment for microcontrollers from Renesas are to be executed.</p>
Floating License	<p>A license to be assigned to a server PC and used among PCs on a network.</p> <p>This license is managed by the software for floating license management on the same PC on which tools related to the integrated development environment for microcontrollers from Renesas are to be executed or on another PC.</p>
License Manager	<p>A tool for managing a license that mainly provides the following features.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Adding license keys for node-locked licenses ● Specifying an address and a port for the floating license service to enable the settings <p>Starting the use of a floating license in offline mode</p>
Software for Floating License Management	<p>A tool for managing the floating license service that mainly provides the following features.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Adding license keys for floating licenses ● Enabling floating license services <p>*Root privileges are required to use features other than those for displaying the version and usage.</p>
Floating License Service	<p>A service for providing the floating licenses to users with a limit on the period of use within the range of the number of licenses registered with the software for floating license management.</p>
Tools related to the integrated development environments for microcontrollers from Renesas	<p>This refers to tools such as compilers that require licenses. Check the state of registered licenses required for executing each tool.</p>

3.4 Installation

Specify the installer file name and enter the following in the terminal.

```
% sudo installer -pkg license-manager_2.10.00_osx-arm64.pkg -target /
```

The installation location is as follows.

```
/usr/local/renesas-mcutools/
```

You can launch Terminal in the following ways:

1. Press Command+Space to launch Spotlight Search.
2. Type "Terminal."
3. Select "Terminal" from the search results.

3.5 Uninstallation

Enter the following in the terminal.

```
% sudo pkgutil --forget com.renesas.license-manager
```

```
% sudo /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/uninstall.sh
```

If you uninstall, the following warning will be displayed because the license manager configuration file exists in the installation directory.

```
"not empty: /usr/share/renesas-mcutools-license"
```

If you reinstall it, you will be able to use it with the same settings, so there is no need to delete it.

If you want to delete all directories and files, delete the following directories after uninstallation.

```
/usr/local/share/renesas-mcutools-license
```

```
/var/local/renesas-mcutools-license
```

```
~/renesas/mcutools-license
```

3.6 Using a License Manager

3.6.1 Adding a Node-Locked license

Enter the following command in the terminal.

```
$ /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/license-manager --add <License key>
```

3.6.2 Checking the added Node-Locked license

Enter the following command in the terminal.

```
$ /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/license-manager --list
```

3.6.3 Removing a Node-Locked license

Enter the following command in the terminal.

```
$ /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/license-manager --delete <License key>
```

3.6.4 Using a floating license

Using a floating license requires setting information in the software for floating license management.

Enter the following command in the terminal.

```
$ /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/license-manager --enable-server-setting [<Address> [<Port>]]
```

3.6.5 Acquiring the offline mode for a floating license

You need to acquire the offline mode to use a floating license in the state where the computer is disconnected from the network environment.

To acquire the offline mode, proceed with the following operation in the state where the computer is connected to the network and the setting of the software for floating license management is enabled.

Enter the following command in the terminal to display the candidate types of offline mode.

```
$ /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/license-manager --list-for-offline-mode
```

Enter the following command in the terminal to acquire the offline mode from among the candidate types of offline mode that have been displayed.

```
$ /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/license-manager --get-offline-mode <Kind> [<Period>]
```

In the period over which the offline mode is enabled, you can continue to use the license even in the state where the software for floating license management cannot be connected.

3.6.6 Others

For other usage methods, enter the following command in the terminal.

```
$ /usr/local/renesas-mcutools/bin/license-manager --help
```
