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A Note on Using Flash Development Toolkit

When using Flash Development Toolkit, take note of the following problem:

- With running the product on Windows Vista or Windows 7

Note: The conditions increased. Check also Document No. 110901/tn4. (Sep. 21, 2011)

1. Product and Versions Concerned

Flash Development Toolkit
V.4.02 Release 00 and later

2. Description

On Windows Vista or Windows 7, if you start the product in the Basic Simple interface Mode, the Application Clash dialog box appears on Windows.

3. Conditions

This problem arises if the following conditions are both satisfied:

- (1) The host Os is Windows Vista or Windows 7.
- (2) Data on the external storage device (hard disk, USB memory, or others) of the host PC is registered as "Download File" in the product. Next, the external storage device is disconnected from the PC; then the product is re-started in the Basic Simple interface Mode.

4. Workaround

To avoid this problem, register data on the internal hard disk of the host PC; not on an external storage device.

If you need to use an external storage device, do not disconnect it from the PC while Flash Development Toolkit is operating.

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
