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# A Note on Using Flash Development Toolkit

When using Flash Development Toolkit, take note of the following problem:

With running the product on Microsoft Windows Vista or Windows 7

#### 1. Product and Versions Concerned

Flash Development Toolkit V.4.02 Release 00 and later

## 2. Description

On Windows Vista or Windows 7, if you starts Flash Development Toolkit in the Main mode or the Basic Simple Interface mode, the Application Clash dialog box appears on Windows.

In RENESAS TOOL NEWS Document No.110716/tn11, we informed you that this problem arose only in the Basic Simple Interface mode. However, it also arises in the Main mode.

### 3. Conditions

This problem arises if the following conditions are both satisfied:

- (1) The host Os is Windows Vista or Windows 7.
- (2) Data on the external storage device (hard disk, USB memory, or others) of the host PC is registered as "Download File." And after the external storage device is once disconnected from the PC, the product is restarted in the Main mode or Basic Simple Interface mode.

## 4. Workaround

To avoid this problem, read in the data to be registered as "Download File" from the internal hard disk of the host PC; not from an external storage device.

If you need to use an external storage device, do not disconnect it from the PC while Flash Development Toolkit is operating.

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
