Information about restriction on external Ethernet PHY device selection for R-IN32M3-CL.

1. Condition

When using 10Base-T half-duplex mode

2. Restriction

10Base-T half-duplex Ethernet PHY may support and operate in the 2 following modes:

- 1. Transmitted frame from MII is propagated to MDI and looped back to MII
- 2. Transmitted frame from MII is propagated to MDI

Selected Ethernet PHY for R-IN32M3-CL shall operate in mode 2. They shall thus either:

Be able to disable the loopback function by register setting


or

- Not support the loopback function on 10Base-T half-duplex mode.

3. Background

When using Ethernet PHY which supports loopback function, the following behavior has a potential to cause an endless frame transfer between Ethernet ports.

- (1) Port1 on R-IN32M3-CL receives a frame
- (2) Ethernet switch in R-IN32M3-CL forwards the frame to port0
- (3) Ethernet PHY for port0 transmits the frame not only to MDI but also to MII (Loopback)



- (4) Ethernet switch in R-IN32M3-CL receives the looped-back frame from PHY and forwards it to port1
- (5) Ethernet PHY for port1 transmits the frame to MDI and loops back it to MII
- (6) Repeats (2) (5)

- 5	Supports disabling capability for loopback function by register (If loopback function is supported)
