

## Note on Using Flash Development Toolkit

When using Flash Development Toolkit, take note of the following problem:

- With executing script files
- 

### 1. Product and Versions Concerned

Flash Development Toolkit

V.3.2 through V.3.07 Release 05; and V.4.00 Release 00 and later

### 2. Description

When you execute script files, application errors may arise.

### 3. Conditions

This problem arises if either of the following conditions is satisfied:

- (1) By using one configuration file, two or more script files are executed, and the script files are different from each other in workspaces they use.
- (2) In one script file, there are two or more "workspace" commands which load workspaces on Flash Development Toolkit.

Note that if this problem arises, exit Flash Development Toolkit once.

### 4. Workaround

To avoid this problem, create one configuration file for each workspace; then manage one script file by one configuration file.

Note, however, that create configuration files as follows:

- (1) When typing the path name of a script file into Script file Settings in the Wait-For-Script Configuration dialog box, do not search for the script file by using the Wild Card button, but do by using the File button.
- (2) Give different names to the Log and the Status files from each other by configuration file; then type these name into Log File Name and Status File Name in the Log and the Status File tab.
