QE for Capacitive Touch[RA] V1.1.0: Development Assistance Tool for Capacitive Touch Sensor

Outline

RA Family QE for Capacitive Touch[RA] has been updated from V1.0.0 to V1.1.0.

1. Products and Versions to Be Updated

- QE for Capacitive Touch[RA] V1.0.0

To check the version: From the [Help] menu of e² studio, select [e² studio Installation details] menu > [Installed Software] tab and you will see the version of the 'Renesas QE for Capacitive Touch[RA]'.

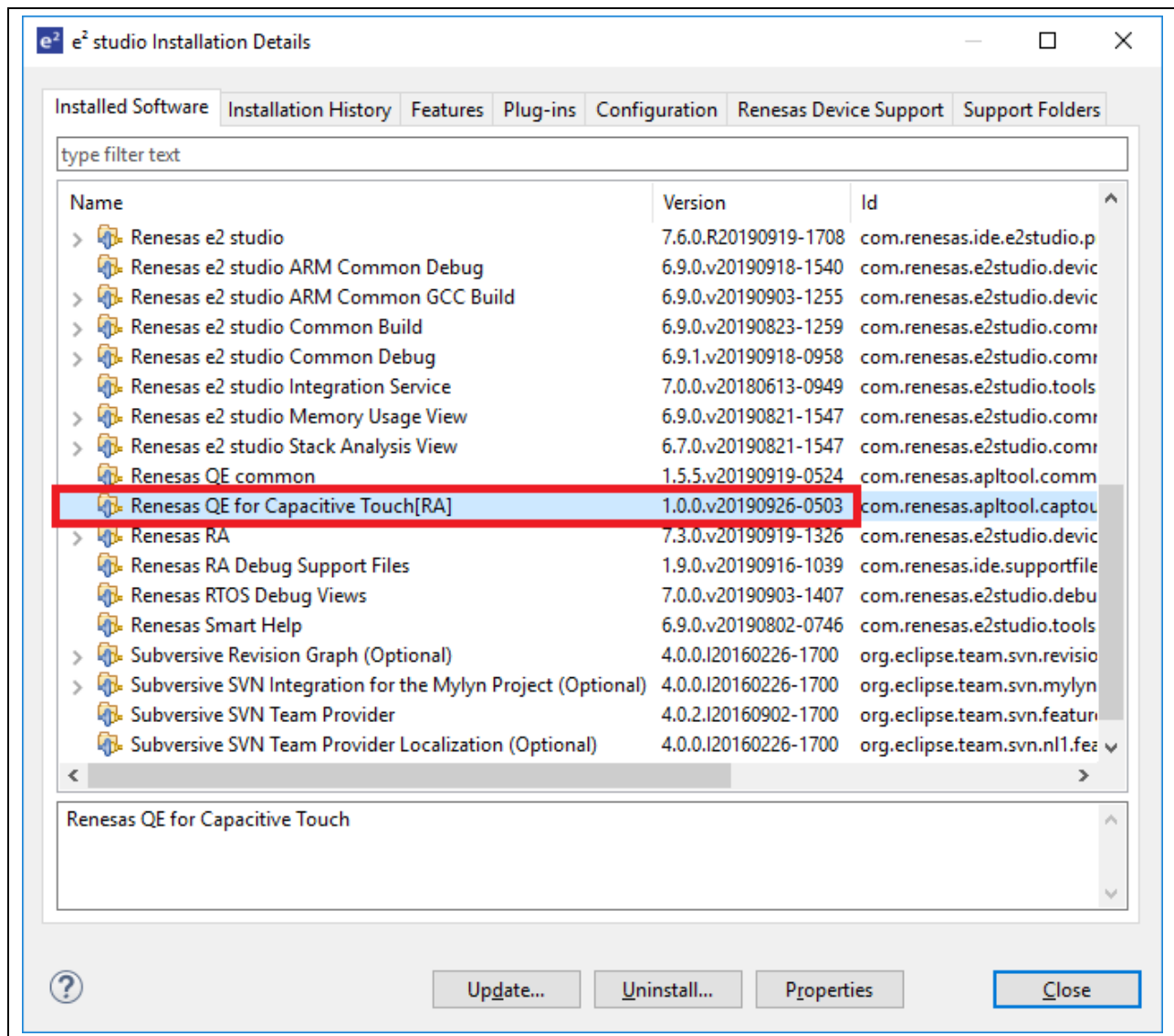


Figure 1 Checking the version of QE for Capacitive Touch[RA]

2. Description of the Update

2.1 New Features

➤ Monitoring through a serial port

The sensitivity monitoring function of QE for Capacitive Touch[RA] can be used without an emulator.

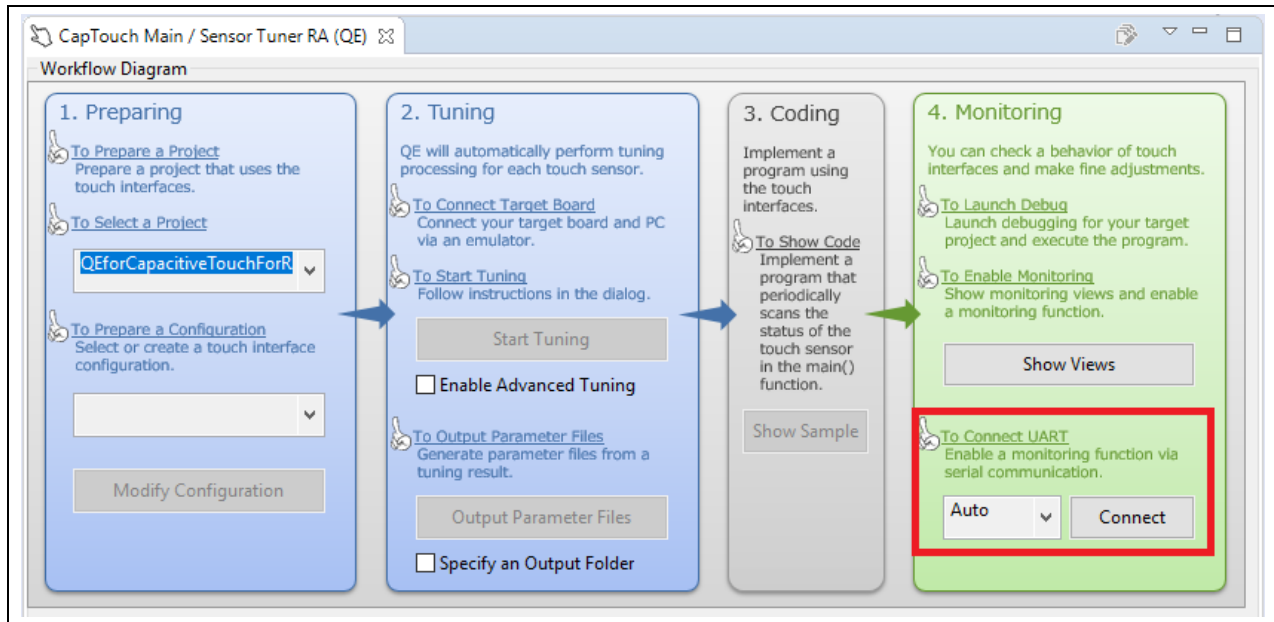


Figure 2 Serial Port Connection Menu

2.2 Feature Improvements

➤ Support for Flexible Software Package (FSP) V1.0.0

FSP V1.0.0 middleware for RA family is now supported.

The FSP components related to QE for Capacitive Touch[RA] are as follows.

➤ Reduction of the touch device tuning time

Two tuning types are now available: initial tuning and tuning of sensitivity only. Selecting [Tuning of sensitivity only] after initial tuning of all items skips non-essential steps, allowing only the required tuning to be performed. This shortens the tuning time compared with the previous version.

3. Feature Introduction

- Noise monitoring through [Standard deviation measured and display]

Securing noise immunity is critical in development of touch devices. For this reason, QE for Capacitive Touch[RA] provides the [Standard deviation measured and display] function. This function enables convenient noise monitoring by calculating and displaying averages of noise-related values based on the data collected during a specified time.

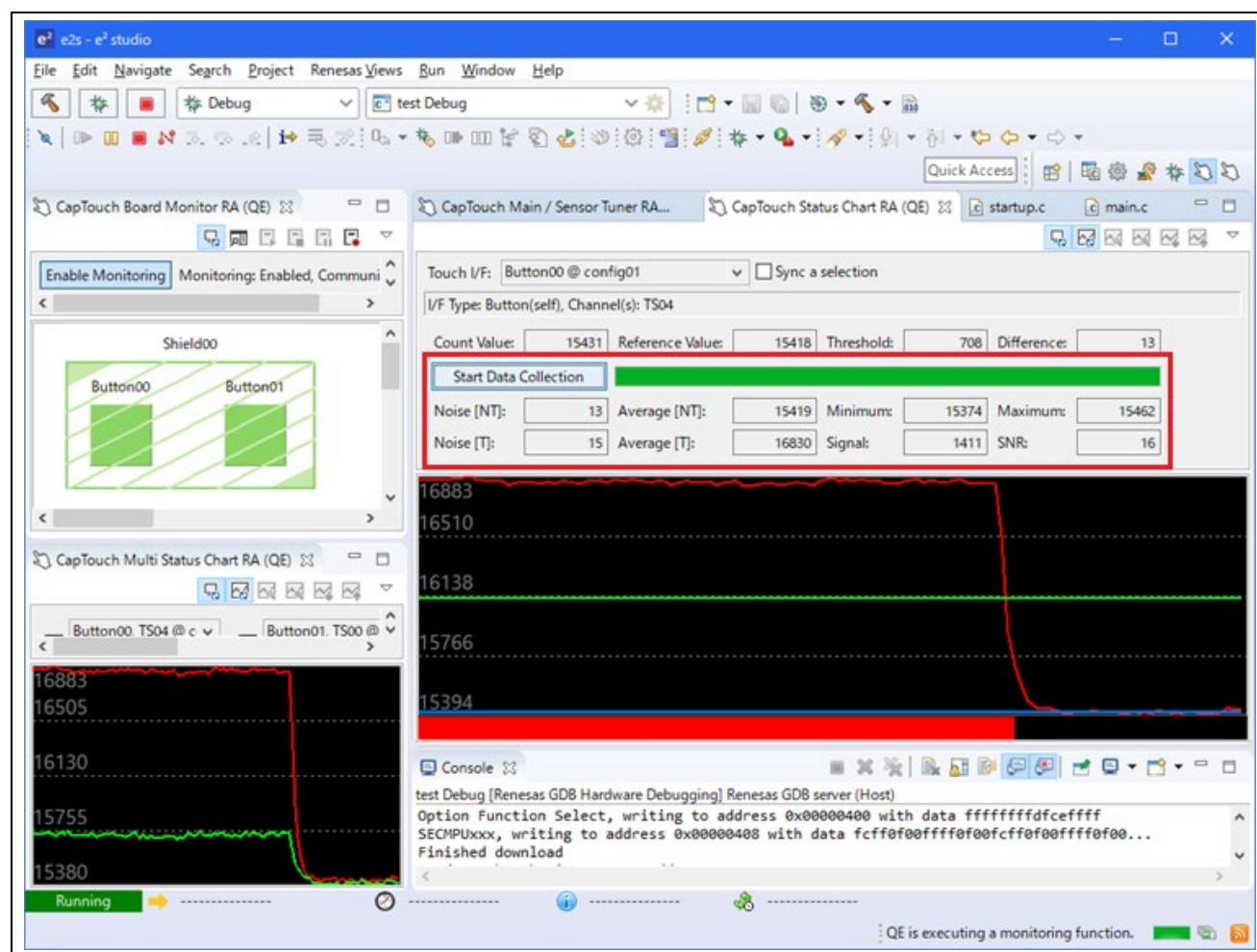


Figure 3 Standard deviation measured and display: Starting data collection and display of measurement results

4. Operating Environment

- e² studio integrated development environment V7.8.0 or later (Scheduled to be released on April 20.)

5. Obtaining the Product

Download the installer for QE for Capacitive Touch[RA] V1.1.0 from the URL below.

6. Installation

The installation procedure is shown below.

- (1) Activate e² studio.
- (2) Click [Help], and then click the [Install New Software...] menu to open the [Install] dialog box.
- (3) Click the [Add...] button to open the [Add Repository] dialog box.
- (4) Click the [Archive...] button, select the installation file (zip file) in the opened file selection dialog box, and then click the [Open] button.
- (5) Click the [OK] button in the [Add Repository] dialog box.
- (6) Expand the [Renesas QE] item shown in the [Install] dialog box, select the [Renesas QE for Capacitive Touch][RA] check box.
Unselect the checkbox for the [Contact all update sites during install to find required software] ^(Note), and then click on the [Next>] button.
- (7) Confirm that the installation target is correct, and then click the [Next>] button.
- (8) After checking the license, select the [I agree accept the terms of the license agreements] radio button if you agree it, and then click on the [Finish] button.
- (9) When the dialog box for selecting a trusted certificate appears, check the displayed certificate, and then click on the [OK] button to continue installation.
- (10) Restart e² studio by following the instructions on the screen.
- (11) Start this product from the [Renesas Views] - [Renesas QE] menu of e² studio.

For details about how to use this product, refer to the QE items from the [Help] menu of e² studio.

Note: To install plug-ins for e² studio other than QE, select [Contact all update sites during install to find required software] before proceeding with the following steps.
