# D/A Converter Operation

#### 1. Abstract

This facility outputs D/A-converted analog voltages from the analog output pin.

The output analog voltage (V) is determined by the value (0-255) set in the DAi (i = 0, 1) register.

Output analog voltage (V) = reference voltage (VREF) 
$$\times \frac{\text{(DAi register set value)}}{256}$$

#### 2. Introduction

The application example described in this document applies to the following MCU:

• MCU: M16C/64 group

This application note can be used with other M16C Family MCUs which have the same special function registers (SFRs) as the above group. Check the manual for any modifications to functions. Careful evaluation is recommended before using the program described in this application note.



# 3. Application Example

Operation

- (1) Write a value to the DAi register (i = 0, 1). D/A conversion will start.
- (2) Set the DAiE (i = 0, 1) bit of the DACON register to 1. The converted analog value will be output from the DAi pin.
- (3) Set the DAiE (i = 0, 1) bit of the DACON register to 0. The DAi pin will go to a high-impedance state, with no analog values output.


#### Supplementary explanation


- To use the DA0 pin, set PD9\_3 of the PD9 register to 0 (input mode).
- To use the DA1 pin, set PD9\_4 of the PD9 register to 0 (input mode).



### 4. How to Set Up

The following shows how to set up the registers to accomplish the operation described in 3, "Application Example." For details about each register, see the hardware manual of the M16C/64 group.






PD9\_3 Port P9\_3 direction bit
0: Input mode
PD9\_4 Port P9\_4 direction bit
0: Input mode

Set the PD9 register's PRC2 bit to 1 before rewriting the register with the next instruction. Be sure that no interrupt or DMA transfer occurs between the instruction that sets the PRC2 bit to 1 and the instruction that rewrites the PD9 register.
