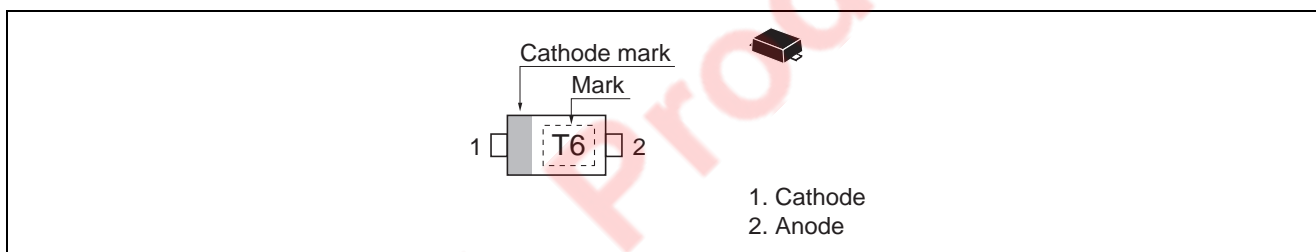
Features

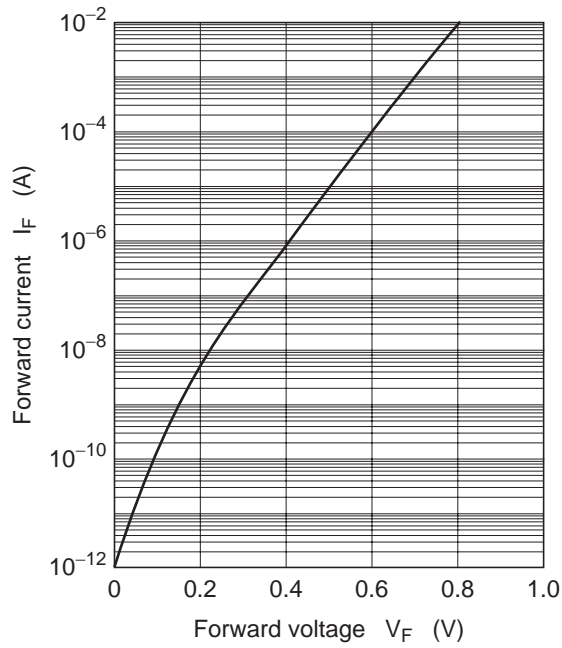


Fig.1 Forward current vs. Forward voltage

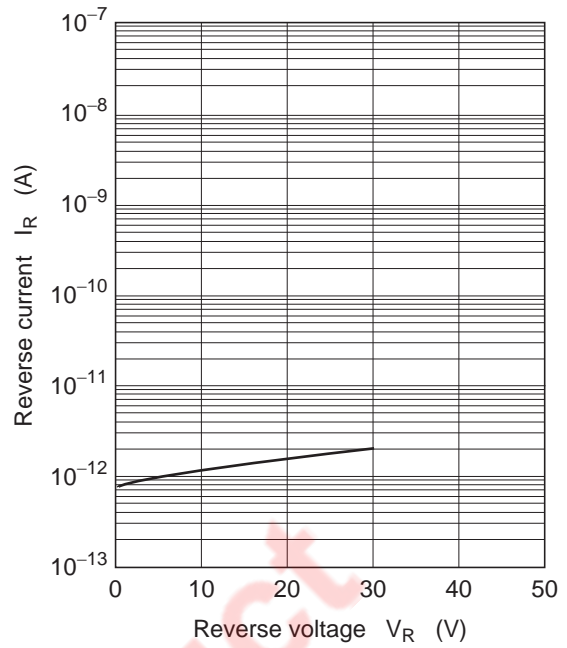


Fig.2 Reverse current vs. Reverse voltage

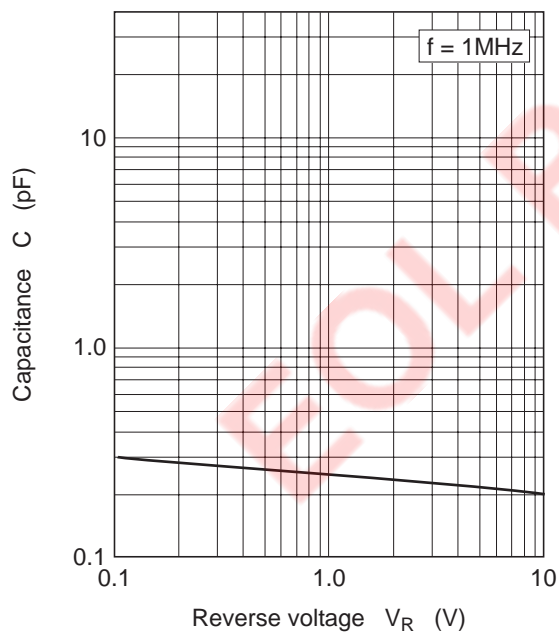


Fig.3 Capacitance vs. Reverse voltage

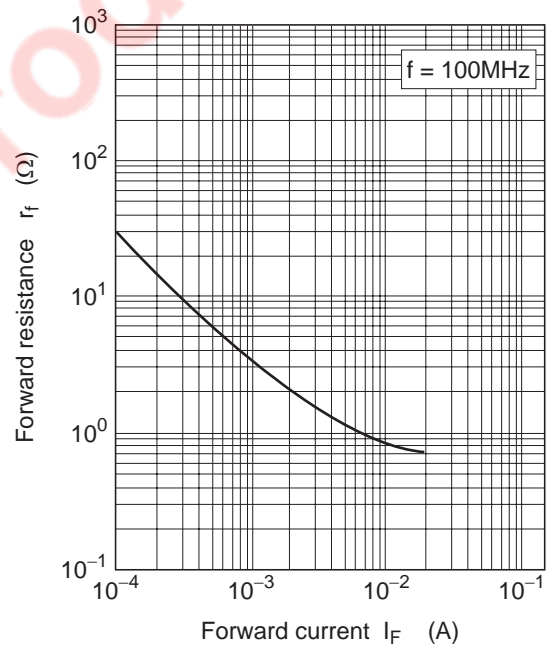


Fig.4 Forward resistance vs. Forward current

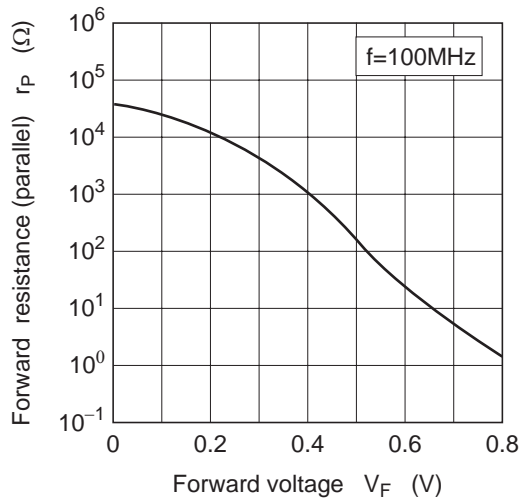
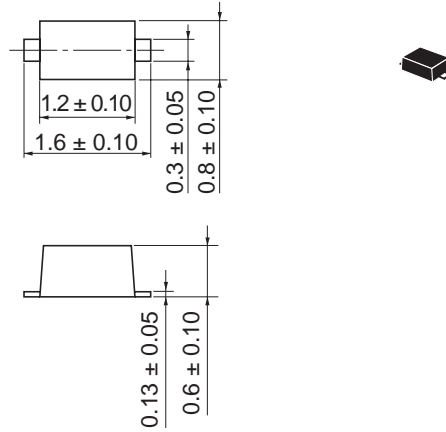


Fig.5 Forward resistance (parallel) vs. Forward voltage
