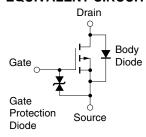

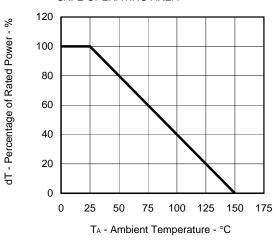

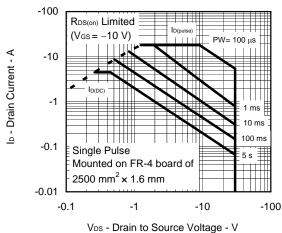
## DERATING FACTOR OF FORWARD BIAS SAFE OPERATING AREA



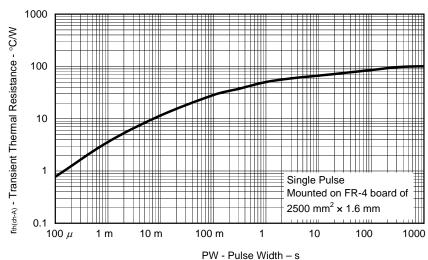
## TOTAL POWER DISSIPATION vs. AMBIENT TEMPERATURE

# TRANSIENT THERMAL RESISTANCE vs. PULSE WIDTH

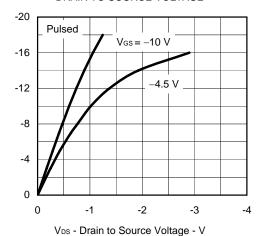

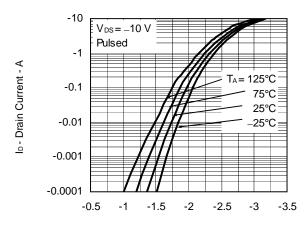

# DRAIN CURRENT vs. DRAIN TO SOURCE VOLTAGE

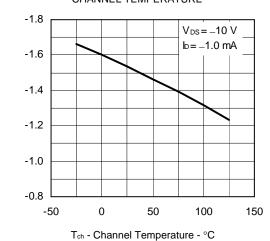

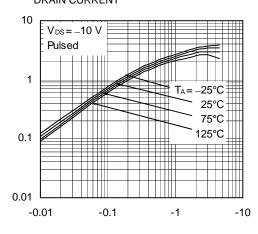

# GATE CUT-OFF VOLTAGE vs. CHANNEL TEMPERATURE

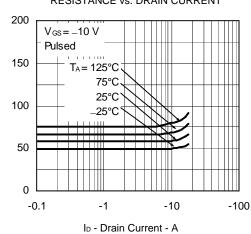


FORWARD TRANSFER ADMITTANCE vs. DRAIN CURRENT

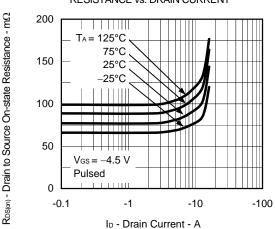

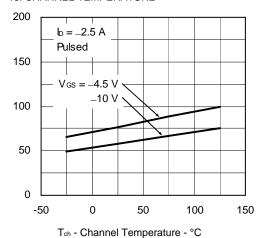

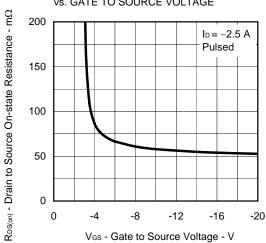

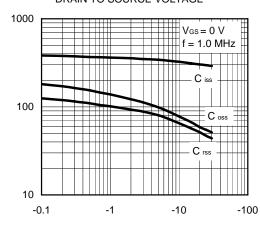
## DRAIN TO SOURCE ON-STATE RESISTANCE vs. CHANNEL TEMPERATURE



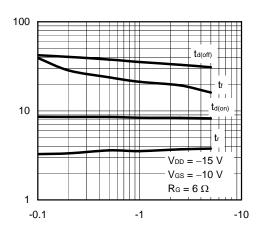
# DRAIN TO SOURCE ON-STATE RESISTANCE vs. GATE TO SOURCE VOLTAGE

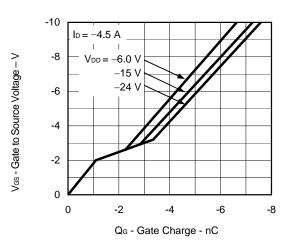

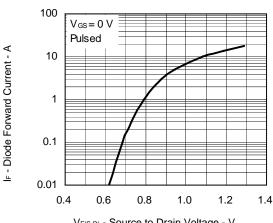
