#### Introduction

This document describes the contents of the “diff” files of RZ/G Verified Linux Package for 64bit kernel (hereinafter referred to as “VLP64”) and instructions to use them.

Please read the “Release Note” of VLP64 v1.0.17-RT carefully before using this document.

## 1. Release Items

VLP64 is delivered by the files listed in **Table 1**. A developed environment of VLP64 v1.0.15-RT can be changed to that of VLP64 v1.0.17-RT by applying the patch files included in diff files without downloading basic packages.

**Note: (\*) If you want to support Gecko68 instead of Gecko78, please use basic gecko packages from VLP64 v1.0.10 due to no changes.**

The above packages are downloaded with the different file names like as "REN\_rzg2\_bsp\_eva\_v10x.tar.gz\_ESW\_2021xxxx.gz". When you use the packages, please rename them to the above file names.

## 2. Patch Application Guide

This chapter describes how to prepare a clean environment of **VLP64 v1.0.15rt** and update it to **VLP64 v1.0.17rt**. It is recommended to prepare and use a clean new environment, but if the environment prepared with **VLP64 v1.0.15rt** is being used, it can also be updated with the section **2.1** or **2.2** below. In this case, it is highly recommended to backup whole environment before updating them. If HTML5 (Gecko) is not required, please refer to only the section **2.1**. If HTML5 (Gecko) is required, please skip the section **2.1** and refer to only the section **2.2**.

**Copy all files obtained from Renesas into your home directory prior to the steps below.**

### 2.1 Patch Application Guide

#### (1) Create a working directory (rzig2\_vlp\_v1.0.15rt) at your home directory and decompress Yocto recipe package of v1.0.15rt

Run the commands below. The name and the place of the working directory can be changed, as necessary. Please replace “*eva*” with “*pro*” for the product version.

```
$ mkdir ~/rzig2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ cd ~/rzig2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ tar zxvf ~/rzig2_bsp_eva_v1015rt.tar.gz
```

Note) In case updating existing environment:

- Please revert the patch which enables HDMI with below command if necessary. Please replace “*directory*” to the path to the directory which stores the patch file.

```
$ patch -R -p1 < directory/0001-BSPv1.0.15-Add-HDMI-support-for-RZ-G2.patch
```

#### (2) Apply the patch file to Yocto recipes and remove a directory and add a file

Run the commands below.

```
$ cd ~/rzig2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ tar zxvf ~/v1015rt-to-v1017rt.patch.tar.gz
$ patch -p1 < v1015rt-to-v1017rt.patch
```

#### (3) Decompress OSS files of v1.0.15-RT to “build” directory

Run the commands below. All OSS packages will be decompressed at once with this '7z' command. Please place all `oss_pkg_v1015rt.7z` files in the same directory before running this '7z' command. 7zipped files are not able to decompress individually.

```
$ cd ~/rzig2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ mkdir build
$ cd build
$ 7z x ~/oss_pkg_v1015rt.7z
```

**(4) Add OSS files**

Run the commands below to remove the old files.

```
$ cd ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt/build/downloads
$ rm -rf git2/github.com.renesas-rz.rzg_trusted-firmware-a.git
```

Run the commands below to add the new files. Copy the compressed OSS diff file to the home directory and decompress the new files.

```
$ cd ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt/build
$ 7z x ~/v1015rt-to-v1017rt.oss_packages.7z
```

**(5) Build new BSP**

Now it is ready to build the BSP. Please build it according to the Release Note section 3.1. Note that the below steps in the chapter 3 of the Release Note is not necessary. These steps overwrite your environment.

- (1) Create a working directory (rzg2\_vlp\_v1.0.15rt) at your home directory, and decompress Yocto recipe package
- (5) Decompress OSS files to “build” directory

## 2.2 Patch Application Guide for HTML5 (Gecko78)

### (1) Create a working directory (rzg2\_vlp\_v1.0.15rt) at your home directory and decompress Yocto recipe package of v1.0.15rt

Run the commands below. The name and the place of the working directory can be changed, as necessary. Please replace “*eva*” with “*pro*” for the product version.

```
$ mkdir ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ cd ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ tar zxvf ~/rzg2_bsp_eva_v1015rt.tar.gz
$ tar zxvf ~/rzg2_bsp_gecko78_v1015rt.tar.gz (*)
```

**Note:** (\*) If you want to support Gecko68 instead of Gecko78, please use “rzg2\_bsp\_gecko68\_v109rt.tar.gz”.

Note) In case updating existing environment:

- Please revert the patch which enables HDMI with below command if necessary. Please replace “*directory*” to the path to the directory which stores the patch file.

```
$ patch -R -p1 < directory/0001-BSPv1.0.15-Add-HDMI-support-for-RZ-G2.patch
```

### (2) Apply patch files to Yocto recipes

Run the commands below.

```
$ cd ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ tar zxvf ~/v1015rt-to-v1017rt.patch.tar.gz
$ patch -p1 < v1015rt-to-v1017rt.patch
```

### (3) Decompress OSS files of v1.0.15rt to “build” directory

Run the commands below. All OSS packages will be decompressed at once with this '7z' command. Please place all oss\_pkg\_v1015rt.7z files and oss\_pkg\_gecko78\_v1015rt.7z files in the same directory before running this '7z' command. 7zipped files are not able to decompress individually.

```
$ cd ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt
$ mkdir build
$ cd build
$ 7z x ~/oss_pkg_v1015rt.7z
$ 7z x ~/oss_pkg_gecko78_v1015rt.7z (*)
```

**Note:** (\*) If you want to support Gecko68 instead of Gecko78, please use “oss\_pkg\_gecko68\_v1015rt.7z”.

**(4) Add OSS files**

Run the commands below to remove the old files.

```
$ cd ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt/build/downloads
$ rm -rf git2/github.com.renesas-rz.rzg_trusted-firmware-a.git
```

Run the commands below to add the new files. Copy the compressed OSS diff files to the home directory and decompress the new files.

```
$ cd ~/rzg2_vlp_v1.0.15rt/build
$ 7z x ~/v1015rt-to-v1017rt.oss_packages.7z
```

**(5) Build new BSP**

Now it is ready to build the BSP. Please build it according to the Release Note section 3.1. Note that the below steps in the chapter 3 of the Release Note is not necessary. These steps overwrite your environment.

- (1) Create a working directory (rzg2\_vlp\_v1.0.15rt) at your home directory, and decompress Yocto recipe package
- (5) Decompress OSS files to “build” directory
