

Notes on Using the High-performance Embedded Workshop (IDE) --With Moving Workspaces, No. 1 and 2--

Please take note of the following problems in using the High-performance Embedded Workshop:*

- With moving workspaces, No. 1
- With moving workspaces, No. 2

*This IDE is bundled with the software products such as compilers that it manages.

1. Problem with Moving Workspaces, No. 1

1.1 Description

If a workspace is moved to another directory and opened, your High-performance Embedded Workshop may go out of control.

1.2 Workaround

Delete the "project-name.nav" file in the project directory to open the workspaces you have moved to another directory.

1.3 Schedule of Fixing the Problem

We will fix this problem when we revise the High-performance Embedded Workshop within the foreseeable future.

2. Problem with Moving Workspaces, No. 2

2.1 Description

Consider file A is the one on which depend the files that are the targets of execution of a custom build phase, and file B is the output file of the result of the execution.

If a workspace is moved to another directory and opened after a custom build phase has been added to the workspace, the settings made to the names of the files A and B in the New Build Phase dialog box disappear.

2.2 Workaround

Enter the names of the above files A and B again in each text box for the files or click the file name displayed using the Browse button in each tab in the MyPhase Options dialog box.

2.3 Schedule of Fixing the Problem

We will fix this problem when we revise the High-performance Embedded Workshop within the foreseeable future.
