If the following source code is compiled by CC-RX V2.04.01, 0x02040000 is stored for the version.

    int version;
    void main(void)
    {
    version = __RENESAS_VERSION__;
    }
```

1.4 Workaround

Example: -define=__RENESAS_VERSION__=0x02040100

This setting is not necessary if you are not using the <u>_____RENESAS_VERSION__</u> macro. The version value of V2.04.00 (0x02040000) can be used for V2.04.01.

1.5 Schedule for Fixing the Problem

We do not plan to make modifications.

Use the workaround method described in 1.4.
