The Update Programs of the C/C++ Compiler Packages for the SuperH RISC engine; and the H8, H8S, and H8SX Families Bug-Fixed

We have fixed a bug in the update programs of the following C/C++ compiler packages (Windows version only):

- Update program shv9002u.exe, which updates the C/C++ compiler package for the SuperH RISC engine family to V.9.00 Release 02
- Update program h8v6100u.exe, which updates the C/C++ compiler package for the H8, H8S, and H8SX families to V.6.01 Release 00

1. Description

The problem that the execution of the above update programs does not install new tool chains has been resolved.

We are releasing the update programs on our homepage on June 6. So download the bug-fixed shv9002u2.exe file (for the SuperH RISC engine family) or the bug-fixed h8v6100u2.exe file (for the H8, H8S, and H8SX families) to replace yours with it as follows:
