Please note the followings when you use the E10A-USB emulator selecting the SH7290 of the SH-Mobile device group.

#### [Problems]

- When the function of downloading to the external flash memory is used, an error may be reported so that the emulator will not operate normally.
- When any of the following operations is performed within a range where the difference between the start and end addresses of memory operation is H68 or larger, an error may be reported so that the emulator will not operate normally:
  - Operating the window
    - [Memory] menu: Find, Copy, and Save (Openingthe [Memory] window does not apply.)
  - Operating commands

MEMORY\_DISPLAY, MEMORY\_MOVE, FILE\_SAVE, and FILE\_VERIFY

### [Notes]

- Do not use the function of downloading to the external flash memory.
- To perform the memory operation mentioned above, specify the start and end addresses so that their difference will be smaller than H68 (this is H66 or H'64 when accessing in word or longword units, respectively) when accessing in byte units.
- To view the contents of memory, use the [Memory] window instead of the MEMORY\_DISPLAY command if the difference between the start and end addresses is H68 (this is H66 or H'64 when accessing in word or longword units, espectively) or larger when accessing in byte units.
